The Stewards heard from the Competitors' Representative, the Teamprinciple, the Teammanager, the engineer and the Driver concerned, have considered the following matter, determine the following:

Decision: There is no significant and relevant new element which was unavailable to the parties

seeking the review at the time of the decision concerned. The Petition is therefore

dismissed.

Reason: The Stewards' decision that Car 17 was in breach of Article 16.1. d) of 2022/2023 FIA

Formula E World Championship Sporting Regulations for causing a collision with Car 16 at T19 was made during the Race. It was decided, with the help of the Driver Advisor, that Car 17 was wholly to blame for the collision. It was also considered that Car 17 hit

car 16 when the driver tried to overtake car 16.

The Petition contends are not providing any new significant and relevant elements

which were unavailable at the time of our decision being made.

Article 14.3 of the FIA International Sporting Code states "The Decision of the stewards as to whether or not such an element exists is not subject to appeal..."
